**Armor of God.** “Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand, you will still be standing. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God” (Ephesians 6:13-17).

**1 Peter 1:15-16.** But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”

**Romans 3:23.** For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

**Romans 6:23.** For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**John 3:16-17.** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

**Acts 4:12.** Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.

**1 John 1:9.** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

**Acts 17:30-31.** In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent. For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to all men by raising him from the dead.

**Romans 10:9-10.** If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

**Gospel Message.** Jesus tells us that we must spread God’s message of salvation throughout the world so that all may hear and have the chance to respond to the good news.
